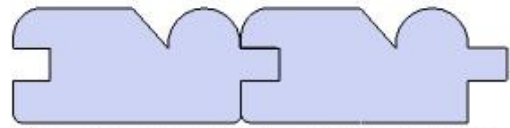

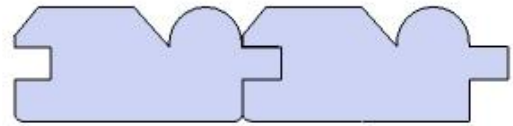

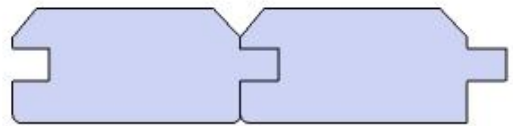

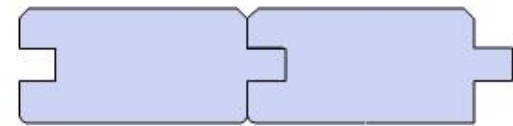
Typical section traditional Cock Bead



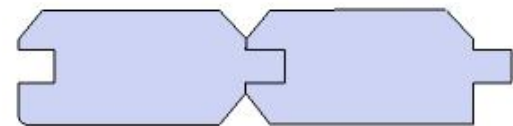
Typical section traditional P.T.G.V & Bead
